

PLAYER EXPECTATIONS

1. Tennis at Redmond High School is a team sport. We win together. Do not let your teammates down.
2. Players are expected to attend all practices and games as scheduled and arrive on time. Appointments should be made outside of our regularly scheduled practice time. If you are at school, we will expect you at games and practices. If you are **not** at school, email Coach Rowley, or Coach Schnierer by 1:00 to let them know you are sick. Telling a teammate to tell a coach isn't acceptable. Unexcused absences will result in a one game suspension for each practice or game missed. Chronic tardiness to practice and games will result in dismissal from the team.
3. Players are expected to be respectful to one another, opposing teams, and coaches. Opponents and their coaching staffs are spoken to only with respect and deference. If you have issues with your opponent(s) behavior or their coaches behavior, please stop the match and contact your coach.
4. Players are expected to communicate directly with their coach. If you have a concern, bring it directly to the coach. It is important that **the player** come and deal with the concern/issue directly. Coaches will send team info via e-mail, text, or website. You are expected to make sure that your coach has a contact e-mail address and phone number for you.
5. Challenges will be allowed at the coaches discretion. Players may challenge other players, but may not move up the ladder more than one spot ahead of them.
6. Players are expected to follow the team dress code and be prepared with water bottles/snacks, and etc.. Tennis appropriate attire includes: shorts/warmup pants/sweatpants, t-shirt (long or short sleeved), and tennis shoes.
7. Players are expected to demonstrate a full commitment to Redmond High School Tennis. All athletes and coaches have family, homework, grading, and other commitments, so the earliest anyone is allowed to leave is 6PM on match days.
8. Players are expected to refrain from using drugs and alcohol. LWSD drug & alcohol policy will be enforced.
9. Players are expected to take responsibility for actions. We do not make excuses.
10. Players are expected to maintain a strong focus on their studies in order to ensure success in the classroom as well as on the courts.
11. Players are expected to put the needs of the team before their individual needs. Watch and cheer on your teammates.
12. Players are expected to maintain self-discipline at all times during the course of practices and games. This includes no swearing, no throwing rackets, or balls.
13. Players are expected to ride the bus, with the team, to away games. Busses will leave on time.
